Unit 2 What is it like for someone to follow God? (People of God)

Religious Education helps pupils to make sense of religion and worldviews, reflecting on their own ideas and ways of living

Theological Vocabulary

- **Christian**—A person who follows and believes in the teachings of Jesus, God and the Holy Spirit.
- **The Bible** a religious/holy book for Christians
- **God**—Christians believe in one God who is both loving and forgiving
- **Old Testament** stories in the Bible from before Jesus was born
- **New Testament** the second part of the Bible where Jesus, his followers and his teachings are introduced
- **People of God** those who choose to live by God's commands
- **Covenant** a pact that God gave humans with rules to obey and in return he had a promise to keep
- **Hope** —believing that good things will happen as promised by God
- **Jewish**—A person who follow and believes in the teachings of one God

- Make links between the story of Noah and how we live in school and the wider world.

Understanding Impact

- Make simple links between promises in the story of Noah and promises that Christians make at a wedding ceremony

The rainbow was used as a sign of hope for the future.

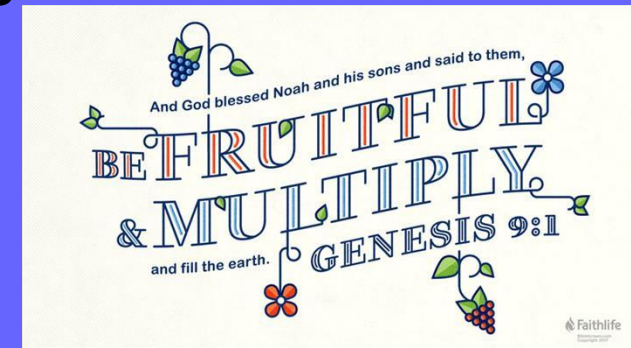


Christian weddings
