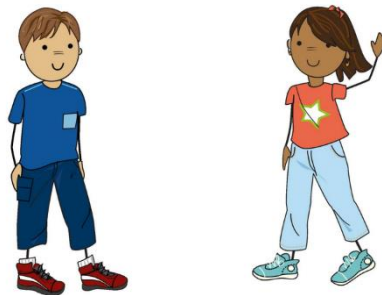




Curriculum Overview: MFL

Year 3



Phonics

Les salutations (Greetings)

In this unit pupils will learn the vocabulary for basic greetings in French. Pupils will participate in a short oral conversation by the end of the unit.




Les couleurs et les nombres (Colours & Numbers)

In this unit pupils will learn to count to ten as well as learning ten popular colours in the foreign language.




Les fruits (Fruits)

In this unit pupils will learn 10 fruits and be introduced to 'I like' and 'I do not like'. By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to say which fruits they like and do not like.

<p><u>J'apprends le français (I Am Learning French)</u></p> <p>By the end of the unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to be able to introduce themselves, say how they feel and have a wider appreciation for the country/countries where French is spoken.</p>	<p><u>Les légumes (Vegetables)</u></p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn 10 common vegetables in their plural form. They will learn the necessary vocabulary to be able to take part in a role-play activity based a vegetable market stall.</p>	<p><u>Les saisons (Seasons)</u></p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn the 4 seasons of the year along with a key feature for each season in French. By the end of the unit pupils will have the skills and knowledge to say which is their favourite season and why.</p>

<p><u>Je me présente (Presenting Myself)</u></p> <p>By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to talk about themselves in French. Pupils will ask questions and answer using a range of personal details including name, age, where they live and nationality.</p>	<p><u>Les vêtements (Clothes)</u></p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn to describe what they are wearing in French. This unit brings together the grammar covered in previously so that pupils can say and write what they are packing in their suitcase for a holiday.</p>	<p><u>Quel temps fait-il ? (What Is the Weather?)</u></p> <p>In this unit pupils will describe the weather and present a weather forecast. This will link vocabulary with map work and compass points. They will improve both language and cultural knowledge.</p>	



Year 6



Ma Famille (My Family)

By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills to make a presentation about their own/a fictitious family in both spoken and written form in French. Pupils will start to integrate previously learnt language with newly acquired vocabulary.

La date (The Date)

Days of the week, months of the year and numbers 1-31 will be introduced, revised and consolidated. By the end of this unit, pupils will have the knowledge and skills to say the date and when their birthday is in French.

Au salon de thé (At the Tea Room)

By the end of this unit pupils will have the knowledge and skills necessary to perform a short role-play in a French tearoom. Pupils will say and write what they are ordering using a wider range of vocabulary.
